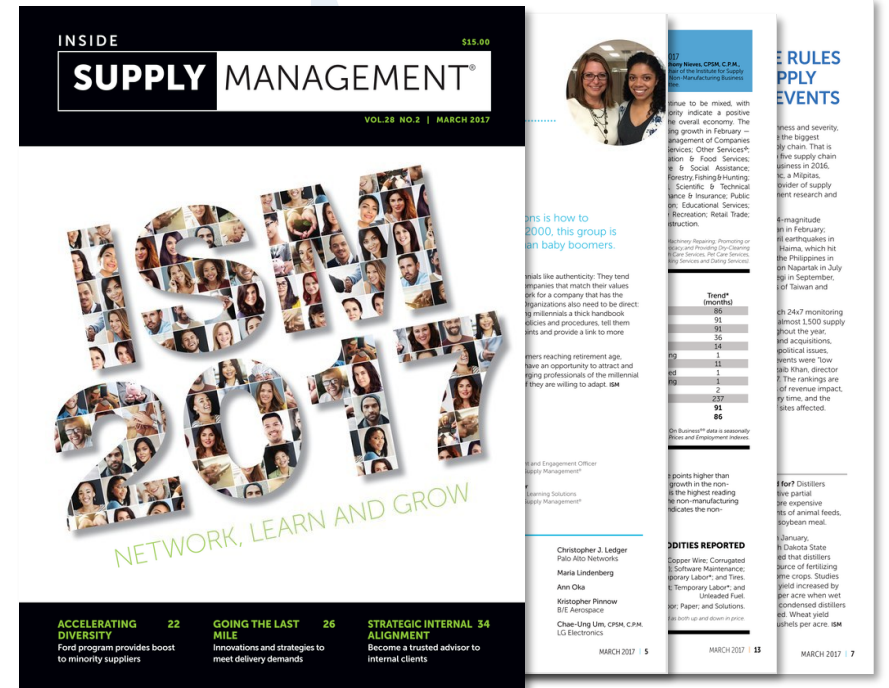

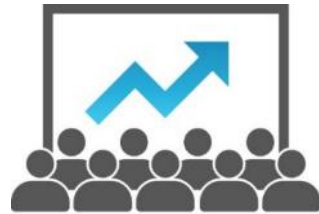

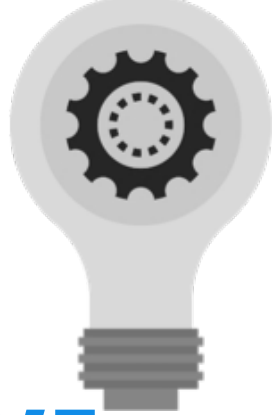

CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL IN SUPPLY MANAGEMENT

CRITERIA

Pass three Exams

- **Exam 1 – Foundations of Supply Management**

Contracting and Negotiation, Social Responsibility, Cost and Finance, Sourcing, International Supplier Relationship Management. 165 Questions; 2 hrs 45 minutes

- **Exam 2 – Effective Supply Management Performance**

Forecasting, Materials and Inventory Management, Logistics, Organization and Department Assessment, Product and Service Development, Quality, Planning. 165 Questions; 2 hrs 45 minutes

- **Exam 3 – Leadership in Supply Management**

Leadership, Strategic Sourcing, Risk Compliance. 180 Questions; 3 hrs

Document Work Experience

Three years full-time professional supply management experience with a regionally accredited bachelor's degree or international equivalent **OR** Five years full-time professional supply management experience without a qualified degree.

Submit CPSM® Original Certification Application

Applications are accepted online at www.instituteforsupplymanagement.org – CPSM/CPSD Certification.

Recertify

To maintain your certification, you must recertify every three (3) years with 60 Continuing Education Hours (CEHs).

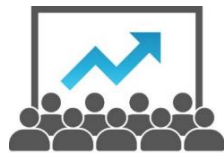
CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS

Continuing Education Hours (CEHs) are needed to recertify ISM-issued certifications. ISM will accept CEHs related to business, computers, your job, your company, or your product.

At least two-thirds of the CEHs must be educational in nature. One-third may be earned in the professional contributions category.

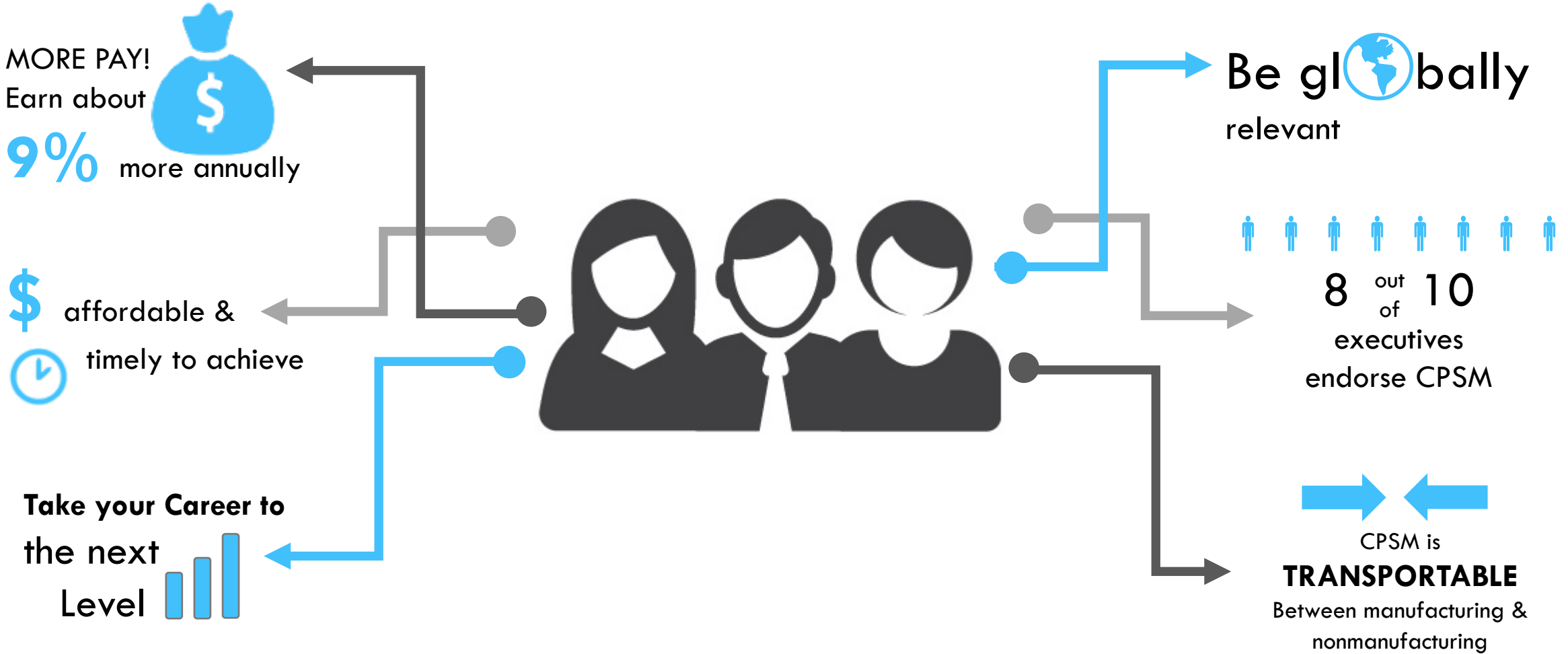

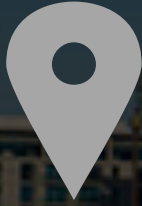
